

Guidelines: Abstracts should include (i) a title of no more than 25 words, (ii) content of no more than 300 words and (iii) the authors' names and affiliations, with the contact person highlighted. The document is submitted (i) in Word format, Times New Roman 12 and 1.5 line spacing, (ii) with the title in bold, font size 14 and (iii) with the authors' affiliation in size 10. The field covered by the proposed paper should be specified in the abstract.

Important dates:

- 1) July 15, 2023: Deadline for abstract submission
- 2) July 17 to July 24, 2023: Selection of papers
- 3) July 26, 2023: Announcement of selected papers and transmission of ppt format and manuscripts
- 4) August 4, 2023: Preparation of presentation program
- 5) September 5, 2023: Deadline for submission of ppts
- 6) September 11 to 15: University Week/Summer School
- 7) September 30, 2023: Submission of manuscripts for publication
- 8) October 2, 2023: Reading committees set up
- 9) November 2, 2023: Submission of comments
- 10) November 30, 2023: Return of responses to comments
- 11) December 1, 2023 to January 31, 2024: Publication process for selected articles


